AVAILABILITY

Available to any municipality or county in which the Utility operates the local distribution system or to the State of Alabama for service at a location adjacent to an electric distribution system of the Utility.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to the entire requirements of electric service for traffic signals when all fixtures, lamps, controls and other equipment including wiring to the point of connection with the Utility's distribution system are owned, installed, operated and maintained by the municipality or other governmental body.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Single-phase service at the available nominal secondary voltage for twenty-four(24) or less hours per day operation.

MONTHLY RATE

7.9¢ per kilowatt-hour(kWh)

DETERMINATION OF BILLING ENERGY

Energy billed shall be metered, determined by test, or on agreement between the Consumer and the Utility, may be taken as the sum of manufacturers' wattage ratings of all lamps and control equipment operated simultaneously multiplied by 730 hours (average number of hours per month) and divided by 1,000 to determine kilowatt-hours(kWh).

MINIMUM BILL

In consideration of the readiness of the Utility to furnish such service there shall be a monthly minimum bill of \$5.00.

PAYMENT

Bills for service rendered hereunder are payable within fourteen(14) days from the due date, and if not paid within such period become delinquent and subject to service charges as set forth in the Utility's Rules and Regulations.

TAX PROVISIONS

In the event any privilege, license, franchise, use, occupational, or other similar tax is imposed on the Utility by any government authority, either Federal, State or local, in excess of those in effect on October 1, 1982, there shall be added to the above rates and charges, an amount, calculated on a pro-rata basis, sufficient to recover any such tax or taxes.

GENERAL

The amount calculated at the above rate will be increased or decreased under the provisions of the Utility's Rate "ECA" (Energy Cost Adjustment) by applying the effective Energy Cost Adjustment factor.

This rate schedule supercedes and replaces Rate "620", dated March 1, 1984, and applies to all billing rendered for traffic signal service on or after November 1, 2007, and shall continue from month to month until rescinded.

TERM OF CONTRACT

Service under this rate shall be for an initial period of one(1) year and shall be extended thereafter from year to year until terminated by ninety(90) days written notice given by either party to the other prior to the expiration of any yearly period.
