AVAILABILITY

Available for seasonal or temporary service as defined by the Utility's Rules and Regulations, subject to the provisions of the Utility's Rules and Regulations covering such service, and subject further to the provisions of this classification. Except where the Utility's electric rate classification provides otherwise, this classification is optional.

MONTHLY RATE

The applicable electric rate classification plus twenty-five percent (25%), applied monthly during the period of connected seasonal or temporary service.

MINIMUM MONTHLY BILL

The minimum monthly bill due under this classification shall be equal to the greatest amount of the following:

- 1) Twenty dollars (\$20.00)
- 2) The monthly minimum requirements of the applicable classification plus twenty-five percent (25%)
- 3) Any annual minimum charge required by the Utility due to idle facilities or unusual service requirements, and which annual minimum charge is to be paid on a monthly basis.

PAYMENT

Bills for service rendered hereunder are payable within fourteen(14) days from due date and if not paid within such period become delinquent and subject to charges as set forth in the Utility's Rules and Regulations.

TAX PROVISIONS

In the event any privilege, license, franchise, use, occupational, or other similar tax is imposed upon the Utility by any governmental authority, either Federal, State or local, in excess of those in effect on October 1, 1983, there shall be added to the above rates and charges, an amount, calculated on a pro-rata basis, sufficient to recover any such tax or taxes.

GENERAL

Bills for service under this rate will be increased or decreased under the provisions of the Utility's Rate "ECA" (Energy Cost Adjustment) by applying the effective Energy Cost Adjustment factor.

The provisions set forth above supercede and replace those provisions affecting seasonal or temporary service, dated January 1, 1984, and apply to all billing rendered for seasonal and temporary services on or after March 1, 1985, and shall continue from month to month until rescinded.
