AVAILABILITY

Available to consumers in all areas served by the Utility.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable for service to single residences, individual family apartments and individual recreational vehicle units. Service shall not be resold or shared with others except that when two or more family dwellings are served through a single meter, all provisions of the rate and minimum shall be applied as though each dwelling unit had been separately metered and the actual metered consumption were divided equally between each unit.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Single-phase 60 Hertz, service at approximately 120 or 120/240 Volts.

MONTHLY RATE

CUSTOMER CHARGE:

\$12.00 per customer; plus

CHARGE FOR ENERGY:

8.97¢ per kWh for all kWh's

MINIMUM MONTHLY BILL

Monthly bills for service provided hereunder shall not be less than \$12.00, plus applicable taxes.

RECONNECTION CHARGE

When service under this classification is suspended at the Consumer's request for convenience or seasonal reasons, a reconnection charge of \$66.00 must be paid in full to the Utility before service will be re-established. Service reconnection is available during the Utility's normal business hours, and then provided any past due indebtedness owed by the Customer to the Utility has been paid in full.

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PAYMENT

Bills for service rendered hereunder are payable within fourteen(14) days from due date and if not paid within such period become delinquent and subject to service charges as set forth in the Utility's Rules and Regulations.

TAX PROVISIONS

In the event any privilege, license, franchise, use, occupational, or other similar tax is imposed upon the Utility by any governmental authority, either Federal, State or local, in excess of those in effect on October 1, 2005, there shall be added to the above rates and charges, an amount, calculated on a pro-rata basis, sufficient to recover any such tax or taxes.

GENERAL

The amount calculated at the above rate will be increased or decreased under the provisions of the Utility's Rate "ECA" (Energy Cost Adjustment) by applying the effective Energy Cost Adjustment factor.

This rate schedule supercedes and replaces Rate Classification "600", Sixth Revised Sheet dated January 1, 2007, and applies to all billing rendered for retail electric residential service on or after November 1, 2007, and shall continue from month to month until rescinded.

TERM OF CONTRACT

Service under this classification shall be for an initial period of one(1) year and thereafter from month to month until terminated by proper notice.
