AVAILABILITY

Available to any public or governmental agency or authority, including the State of Alabama, for service along any highway adjacent to an electric distribution system of the Utility.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable only to all series or multiple street or highway illumination, including ornamental and whiteway lighting where all fixtures, supporting poles or structures, circuit breakers and relays, circuit wiring, and initial lamps, are owned, installed, and maintained by the Customer. Service hereunder shall be subject to the additional terms and conditions set forth in Special Rules and Regulations of the Utility governing application of this rate.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Metered single-phase service, 60 Hertz, at available secondary voltages. Three-phase service may be supplied at the option of the Utility however, the Utility shall not be required to construct any additional facilities for the purpose of supplying three-phase service.

MONTHLY RATE

7.9¢ per kiloWatt-hour

MINIMUM BILL

In consideration of the readiness of the Utility to furnish such service there shall be a monthly minimum bill not less than 75% of the previous month's kiloWatt-hour billing, nor less than \$5.00 per month.

PAYMENT

Bills for service rendered hereunder are payable within fourteen(14) days from due date, and if not paid within such period become delinquent and subject to service charges as set forth in the Utility's Rules and Regulations.

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TAX PROVISIONS

In the event any privilege, license, franchise, use, occupational, or other similar tax is imposed on the Utility by any government authority, either Federal, State or local, in excess of those in effect on October 1, 1982, there shall be added to the above rates and charges, an amount, calculated on a pro-rata basis, sufficient to recover any such tax or taxes.

TERM OF CONTRACT

Contracts for service under this Rate shall be for a minimum period of five(5) years and thereafter extended from year to year unless terminated by written notice from the Consumer sixty(60) days or more prior to the expiration of the initial period or any subsequent anniversary date of the contract.

GENERAL

The amount calculated at the above rate may be increased or decreased under the provisions of the Utility's Rate "ECA" (Energy Cost Adjustment) by applying the effective Energy Cost Adjustment factor.

This rate schedule supercedes and replaces Rate "611", dated March 1, 1984, and applies to all billing for special public highway lighting service rendered on or after November 1, 2007, and shall continue from month to month until rescinded.

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SPECIAL RULES GOVERNING THE APPLICATION OF CLASSIFICATION "611" PUBLIC HIGHWAY LIGHTING - SPECIAL

1. All Customer-owned fixtures, including initial lamps, circuit breakers, fuses, relays, controls, wiring circuits, supporting poles and structures, and any other Customer-owned equipment, shall be installed and maintained by the Customer.
2. The Utility, upon request and at the expense of Customer, will replace or repair such Customer-owned equipment or fixtures, including glassware.
3. The Customer will furnish, install, and maintain the photo-cell, time-clock, or controlling circuit for all Customer-owned fixtures.
4. The Utility will furnish and install all lamp renewals after initial lamps require replacement.
5. Utility service locations for Customer-owned systems shall be specified by the Utility.
6. The Utility shall not be required to make additional investment in special equipment or in underground circuit except under conditions mutually agreeable with the Customer and the Utility.
