AVAILABILITY

Available for outdoor lighting when service can be established directly from the existing secondary distribution lines of the Utility.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Dusk to dawn unmetered service is covered by charges set forth below which also cover initial installation of overhead lines, poles (where applicable), fixture assembly including four foot mounting hardware for standard luminaries and two foot mounting hardware for flood lights, and maintenance including lamp replacements due to burn outs. Such charges do not cover replacement of lamps, luminaries, brackets or overhead lines which are damaged or destroyed due to vandalism or any other cause beyond the Utility's control, such facilities damaged or destroyed under such circumstances to be replaced by the Utility at the Consumer's expense. Lamp renewals and required maintenance will be performed only during regular daytime working hours as soon as practical after notification by the Consumer of the necessity.

- * Poles will be installed to provide the following nominal luminary mounting heights:
1) Standard luminaries; 175W MV & 100W HPS - 25'; 400W MV & 250W HPS - 30'
2) Floodlight luminaries; ALL - 30'.
- ** Not available on new installations unless luminaries are in stock at time of installation.

MINIMUM MONTHLY BILL

The minimum monthly bill shall be the monthly bill calculated on the above monthly rate for luminaries served directly from existing overhead secondary lines, plus

1.25% of the cost of any additional facilities required, provided, however, that such charge shall not be less than \$1.00. The term "additional facilities" shall include, but is not limited to, any underground facilities furnished by the Utility.

PAYMENT

Bills for service rendered hereunder are payable within fourteen(14) days from due date and if not paid within such period become delinquent and subject to service charges as set forth in the Utility's Rules and Regulations.

TAX PROVISIONS

In the event any privilege, license, franchise, use, occupational, or other similar tax is imposed upon the Utility by any governmental authority, either Federal, State or local, in excess of those in effect on October 1, 1982, there shall be added to the above rates and charges, an amount, calculated on a pro-rata basis, sufficient to recover any such tax or taxes.

TERM OF CONTRACT

Service under this classification shall be for an initial period of two(2) years, by written agreement, and shall continue thereafter until terminated by six(6) months written notice given by either the Consumer or the Utility to the other party.

GENERAL

A service charge of \$20.00 shall be paid to the Utility for each light installed on an existing pole. If a pole is required, a service charge of \$40.00 shall be paid to the Utility for the first light, and a \$20.00 service charge shall be paid for each additional light to be installed simultaneously with the first light. All service charges are payable in advance, and are not refundable.

The foregoing schedule of service charges shall apply whenever the Consumer requests that an existing light fixture and/or pole be moved to another location.

This rate schedule supercedes and replaces Rate Classification "612", dated January 1, 1984, and applies to all billing rendered for outdoor lighting service on or after January 1, 1990.
