AVAILABILITY

Available for outdoor lighting when service can be established directly from the existing secondary distribution lines of the Utility.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Dusk to dawn unmetered service is covered by charges set forth below which also cover initial installation of underground lines and conduit, fiberglass light standards (14 ft. mounting height), fixture assembly, and maintenance including lamp replacement due to burnouts. Such charges do not cover replacement of lamps, luminaires, standards or underground lines which are damaged or destroyed due to vandalism or any other cause beyond the Utility's control, such facilities damaged or destroyed under such circumstances to be replaced by the Utility at the Consumer's expense. Lamp renewals and required maintenance will be performed only during regular daytime working hours as soon as practical after notification by the Consumer of the necessity.

MONTHLY RATE

\$5.20 per 9,500 Lumen High Pressure Sodium Lamp when served directly from existing underground secondary distribution lines, plus

1.25% of the cost of any additional facilities required, provided, however, that such charge shall not be less than \$1.00. The term "additional facilities" shall include, but is not limited to, any overhead facilities furnished by the Utility.

MINIMUM MONTHLY BILL

The minimum monthly bill shall be the monthly bill calculated on the above monthly rate.

FIXTURES AND LIGHTING STANDARDS

Fixtures may be chosen from two basic designs, "Traditional" and "Contemporary" and can be viewed on rate schedules in the office. Color of traditional fixtures will be black; color of contemporary fixtures will be dark bronze.

Each fixture will be mounted on a direct embedded fiberglass lighting standard to obtain a mounting height of 14 feet. Each lighting standard will be black or dark bronze in color to match the fixture.

PAYMENT

Bills for service rendered hereunder are payable within fourteen(14) days from due date and if not paid within such period become delinquent and subject to service charges as set forth in the Utility's Rules and Regulations.

TAX PROVISIONS

In the event any privilege, license, franchise, use, occupational, or other similar tax is imposed upon the Utility by any governmental authority, either Federal, State or local, in excess of those in effect on October 1, 1996, there shall be added to the above rates and charges, an amount, calculated on a pro-rata basis, sufficient to recover any such tax or taxes.

TERM OF CONTRACT

Service under this classification shall be for an initial period of five(5) years, by written agreement, and shall continue thereafter until terminated by six(6) months written notice given by either the Consumer or the Utility to the other party.

GENERAL

A charge of \$400.00 per light, which is equal to the estimated cost difference between the underground decorative light and a comparable standard overhead light, shall be paid to the Utility for each light to be installed. Said charge shall be paid prior to the Utility ordering any lighting equipment.

This rate schedule applies to all billing rendered for unmetered decorative outdoor lighting service on or after February 1, 1997, and shall continue from month to month until rescinded.
