### AVAILABILITY

Available to any municipality in which the Utility operates the local electric distribution system or to Baldwin County or to the State of Alabama for service along any highway adjacent to an electric distribution system of the Utility.

### APPLICABILITY

Applicable to street or highway illumination whether by series, multiple or other street lighting circuits. Service hereunder shall be subject to the additional terms, conditions and adjustments set forth in Special Rules and Regulations of the Utility governing application of this rate.

### CHARACTER OF SERVICE

The rates as set forth below cover the initial installation of the luminary and pole, luminary maintenance, and the replacement of lamps and photoelectric controls upon failure subject, however, to the additional terms, conditions, and charges set forth in Special Rules and Regulations of the Utility governing the application of this rate. The Utility shall determine the most economical method of installation and control for all luminaries. The rates set forth below do not cover the replacement of lamps, luminaries, poles, or conductors damaged or destroyed due to vandalism or willful abuse. Such replacements will be performed by the Utility at the Customer's expense.

The above rates are for the luminary only, or the pole only. The underground conduit and wiring system shall be furnished, installed, owned, operated, and maintained by the Customer, unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the Utility and the Customer. Said conduit and wiring system shall be installed according to the latest edition of the National Electrical Code, National Electrical Safety Code, and/or other rules and regulations that may govern such installation. Service is not available using overhead lines.

In the event a pole must be set in an existing concrete or asphalt paved area, the Customer shall be responsible for removing an adequate section of paving so the Utility can set the pole, and the customer shall be responsible for replacing the paving after the pole has been set.

Overhead electric lines necessary to provide service to the Customer's underground wiring system will be installed, owned, operated and maintained by the Utility. The installed cost of such overhead facilities will be billed to the Customer at the Utility's cost on a one-time basis.

### **PAYMENT**

Bills for service rendered hereunder are payable within fourteen(14) days from due date, and if not paid within such period become delinquent and subject to charges set forth in the Utility's Rules and Regulations.

### **TAX PROVISIONS**

In the event any privilege, license, franchise, use, occupational, or other similar tax is imposed upon the Utility by any governmental authority, either Federal, State or local, in excess of those in effect on October 1, 1996, there shall be added to the above rates and charges, an amount, calculated on a pro-rata basis, sufficient to recover any such tax or taxes.

### **TERM OF CONTRACT**

Contracts for service under this Rate shall be for a minimum period of five(5) years and thereafter extended from year to year unless terminated by written notice from the Customer sixty(60) days or more prior to the expiration of the initial period or any subsequent anniversary date of the contract.

### **GENERAL**

The amount calculated at the above rates may be increased or decreased under the provisions of the Utility's Rate "ECA" (Energy Cost Adjustment) by applying the effective Energy Cost Adjustment factor to the average kilowatt-hours consumed per lamp each month.

This rate schedule applies to all billing rendered for Public Street and Highway Ornamental Lighting service on or after September 1, 1997, and shall continue from month to month until rescinded.
