### AVAILABILITY

Available for either a three-inch or one-inch temporary metered connection for construction water or other purpose as approved by Riviera Utilities. This service is provided for installations where water usage does not enter the sewer system and sewer is not changed. Effective for all billings of this rate class rendered on or after July 1, 2020.

### DEPOSIT

#### **(PER HYDRANT METER)**

1" Hydrant meter	\$250.00
3" Hydrant meter	\$1,000.00

The deposit will be applied toward all charges as defined herein after the hydrant meter is returned to Riviera Utilities.

### SETUP CHARGE

#### **(PER HYDRANT LOCATION)**

1" Hydrant Meter	\$50.00
3" Hydrant Meter	\$50.00

The setup charge covers the installation, setup, and removal of the hydrant meter by Riviera Utilities personnel on a single fire hydrant location. Each request to relocate the hydrant meter to a different fire hydrant location will be charged an additional setup charge.

#### **3" Hydrant Meter**

FIRST 10,000 Gallons or Less	\$2.75/1,000 Gallons Plus
ALL over 10,000 Gallons	\$3.25/1,000 Gallons

### PAYMENT

Bills for service rendered hereunder are payable within twenty (20) days from due date and if not paid within such period become delinquent and subject to service charges as set forth in the Utility's rules and regulations.

### TAX PROVISIONS

In the event any privilege, license, franchise, use, occupational, or other similar tax is imposed upon the Utility by any governmental authority, either federal, state, or local, in excess of those in effect on July 1, 2020, there shall be added to the above rates and charges an amount calculated on a pro-rata basis sufficient to recover any such tax or taxes.
