AVAILABILITY

Water is available for metered or otherwise measured service for irrigation or sprinkling at a maximum pressure of 60 PSI. Pressure requirements that are above 60 PSI will require additional equipment. This service is provided for installations where water usage does not enter the sewer system and sewer is not changed. Effective for all billings of this rate class rendered on or after April 1, 2019.

Note: There is no impact fee assessed to install an irrigation meter, only a connection fee based on the requested meter determined by the owner or approved representative. However, a backflow device is required if customer has a potable water service or well used for drinking water on the same parcel.

PAYMENT

Bills for service rendered hereunder are payable within twenty (20) days from due date and if not paid within such period become delinquent and subject to charges as set forth in the Utility's Rules and Regulations.

TAX PROVISIONS

In the event any privilege, license, franchise, use, occupational, or other similar tax is imposed upon the Utility by any governmental authority, either Federal, State or local, in excess of those in effect on April 1, 2019, there shall be added to the above rates and charges, an amount, calculated on a pro-rata basis, sufficient to recover any such tax or taxes.
